Since the beginning of September, Ukrainian defenders have liberated over 4,000 square kilometers - almost the entire Kharkiv Oblast. Contributions have increased by 2,5 times since the counter-offensive was announced, and tripled after the President said that the Ukrainian flag would fly over Balakliya again. We've purchased 4,852 external fixation devices (EFDs), worth 14,645,570 UAH (\$400,152).

It is difficult to overstate the importance of EFDs. They help save people with blast injuries, complex gunshot fractures and limb trauma.





24 reanimobiles have already been sent to save lives. Overall, 82 ambulances have been purchased under Olena Zelenska's initiative.

Now the world can access Made with Bravery, an official Ukrainian marketplace.








Ukrainian stars continue to perform and raise funds towards Medical Aid for Ukraine.

The Ukrainian electro-folk band, ONUKA, gave an outstanding performance at 'Ukrainian Night. Code of freedom,' organized by NEAR UA. 1,000,000 UAH was raised during the event. Half of this sum will go towards the purchase of external fixation devices via UNITED24.

76 countries have already donated towards the Army of Drones.


Most donations come from the US, Ukraine, Canada, the United Kingdom, and Germany. The largest contribution of \$4,000 came from the United States.

Recently, the number of payments in euros and dollars has increased significantly. This project unites Ukrainians and our foreign friends around a central, important goal —

to assemble the world's first drone army for Ukraine.

985 drones reinforced the Armed Forces of Ukraine.

Last week, 10 new UAVs were purchased for the Army of Drones. The total value of drones purchased is \$52,277,973.
